

2013 Chardonnay



Tasting Notes

The 2013 Chardonnay was barrel fermented and went through 10% malolactic fermentation.

As always it was aged for 12 months in 100% neutral oak on the lees, which were stirred a minimum of once a week.

It shows tropical citrus aromas with a hint of vanilla on the nose.

With our typical round and rich mouthfeel, it has flavors of peach and pears while finishing with crisp acidity and hint of minerality.
